
Moving in the Apostolic The "Ascension" or "developmental" gifts


Ephesians 4:11-16

And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ—from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.








Traits of	• Desires to see people work together effectively and closely

Traits of the Prophetic Anointing

- Desires to hear the voice of the Lord
- Seeks revelation from the Spirit through visions and dreams
- Discerns God's heart and purpose
- Speaks words from the Lord to strengthen and encourage others
- Interprets life events and people through the seeing in the Spirit
- Problems when they discount the importance of things in every day life. –when "Out of touch"



Traits of the Pastoral Anointing

- Has a genuine concern for others
- Desires to listen and discern real needs
- Follows up by asking questions at a later time
- Notices when others are missing from groups and contacts them
- · Sought out for support by people in need
- Problems when overwhelmed due to difficulty drawing "boundaries" when called upon.
