

ACTIVATION: Prophecy practice reading the Bible

Psalm 91:1-7

He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High
Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust."

Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler And from the perilous pestilence.

He shall cover you with His feathers, And under His wings you shall take refuge;
His truth shall be your shield and buckler.

You shall not be afraid of the terror by night, Nor of the arrow that flies by day, Nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, Nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday.

A thousand may fall at your side, And ten thousand at your right hand;
But it shall not come near you.

1) Write down your response to the following questions.

- What did you notice?
- Did a word or phrase jump out at you?
- What emotion did you feel?
- What was happening in your spirit?
- Did a picture/word... come to mind?
- Did you have a sense for the person as you read it?

- Ask God to tell you more about these things
- Ask God how He wants to encourage the person, strengthen the person, comfort the person.
- What blessing does He want to release from heaven for them at this time?
- Is there anything else He wants to show you or tell you for them?

2) Check it, Deliver it, Receive Feedback

- ★ Does it line up with the word of God?
- ★ Does it sound like a loving heavenly Father?
- ★ Does it sound like the Good Shepherd?
- ★ Is it encouraging or comforting or building?
- ★ Does it line up with the New Testament covenant of Grace?

→ Share what you received with the person

Then ask the person to give feedback if it resonated with them.
